How To Tie Dye Towels

Wondering how to tie dye towels? Or maybe towels are the last thing in your house you have not tie dyed - yet. Either way, we will show you how to dry off in style with your very own creativity and a little help from the instructions. Bath time/beach time/any time is going to get better.

What you need:

- Tie Dye Kit
- White 100% cotton towels
- Plastic wrap or bag
- Gloves

DIRECTIONS:



- 1. Prewash towels; do not use fabric softener. Do not dry.
- 2. Cover work surface with plastic tablecloth.
- 3. Lay damp towels on prepared work surface.
- 4. Scrunch, tie, and bind towels as desired.
- 5. Wearing protective gloves, prepare dye.
- 6. Apply dye to towels as desired.
- 7. Cover with plastic table cover and <u>let set 6-8 hours</u>.
- 8. Rinse with running water until water is clear. Remove rubber bands if used.
- 9. Wash and dry towels.
- 10. Enjoy your new tie dye towels!
